Overview

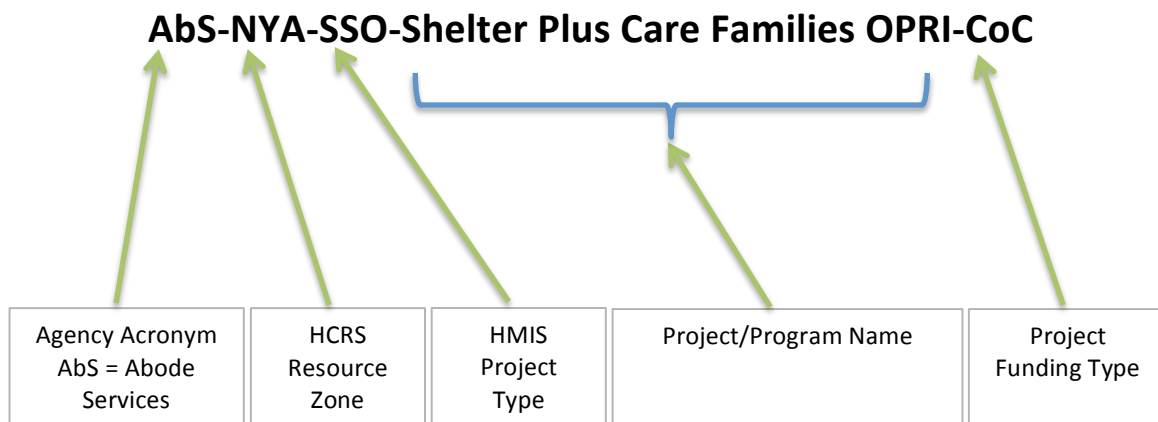
With the introduction of Clarity BitFocus into Alameda County and to support the system level reporting of the Housing Crisis Response System (HCRS), project names have taken on a new structure.

The program naming convention within Clarity includes hyphens that separate distinct information elements (as keyed below). An example appears as follows:



- Agency Acronym – same reference used in ServicePoint (AbS, BACS, OD etc)
- HCRS Resource Zone – appears on the Coordinated Entry Assessment
 - CAF – Countywide
 - EAF – East County Adults and Families
 - MAF – Mid County Adults and Families
 - NA – North County Adults
 - NF – North County Families
 - OA – Oakland Adults
 - SAF – South County Adults and Families
 - **NYA – Not Yet Assigned (assignments may be forthcoming as the HCRS grows)**
- HMIS Project Type – same reference that was used in ServicePoint (ES, TH, PSH etc)
- Project Name – same or close to the same reference used in Service Point
- Project Funding Type – CoC, ESG, HACA, MHSA etc (note these references may not be included in some projects but may be updated over time)
