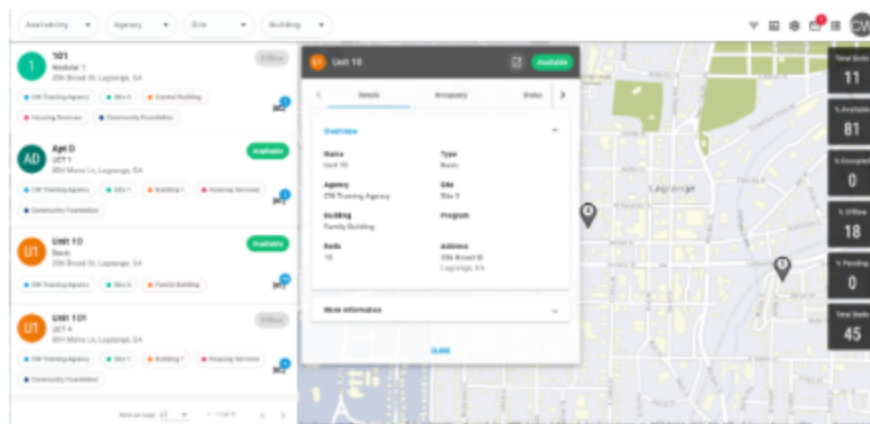

[HUDX-225] HMIS Data Quality Report

This article provides an overview of the report and key definitions from the HMIS Data Dictionary. For the complete programming specifications, please refer to the HMIS Reporting Terminology Glossary.

Key Definitions

Missing Data: Missing data is defined to mean data where the answer is *data not collected*, is null or blank, or where the entire form or table record on which that field resides is completely absent.

Invalid SSNs: Based upon Social Security Information, the following SSN's will be counted as "Data Quality Issues" because they are not valid:
