

## ONE System Housing Move-in Financial Services Job Aid

Housing Move-In Financial Services should be documented for all clients in Scattered-Site programs in the ONE System. These services document the costs required by landlord for occupancy, to establish tenancy, or items directly linked to establishing a home.

## Instructions

- 1. Log on to the ONE system.
- Search for and select the client profile of individual who had move-in costs or items paid.
- Select the correct program under the "Active Programs" heading on right-hand menu.
- 4. Select "Provide Services" from menu under the program banner.

- 5. Select "Housing Move-In Financial Support" from the list of available services.
- 6. Select the appropriate service item associated with type of cost.
- 7. Update the "Event Date" and "Expense Date" (these two dates should be the same). Enter the full dollar amount in the "Expense Amount" field.
- 8. Click "Submit" button after documenting each service item cost.

## **Eligible furniture items**

<u>Kitchen:</u> Bowls, can opener, cleaning supplies, cups/glasses, cutlery, cutting boards, dining table/chairs, dish drying rack, dish towels, kitchen utensils, plates, pots and pans, any appliances necessary for food storage and consumption (e.g., microwave, refrigerator, stove, etc.).

<u>Bedroom</u>: Bedding, bedframe, clothes hanger, infant furniture, mattress, nightstand, hypoallergenic mattresses, or pillow covers.

<u>Bathroom</u>: Bathmat, cleaning supplies, shower/bath curtains, toiletries, towels.

Living room: Coffee/end tables, couch, lamps/lighting.

<u>Other items</u>: Air conditioners, air filters, carbon monoxide detectors, heaters, night lights, smoke detectors, trash cans, vacuum cleaners.

**Ineligible costs:** Hiring movers, renting a moving truck, specialty items outside of a provider's normal scope of services or standard items.
